

SUPERMASTERS DIVISION

The Supermasters expands to a 13 team division for 2001. The return of the Potomac Geezers, the matriculation of a Middlebury team from the Masters Division and the appearance of a first time team, the Hounds, combine with the returning 10 teams from 2000.

The Navy Old Goats return as the defending champs and favorites. Tombstone (formerly known as Rock It Pocket) looks to avenge its one goal loss in the 2000 finals. The Rockies return with their core team from 2000. The remainder of the field led by the Frogs, Behind The Back and Magic Wands are all contenders. This is the most balanced division of the tournament.

Take a minute and decipher the colorful names. The Potomac Geezers need no interpretation. Acronyms abound. Hounds is derived from Hoary Old University of Notre Dame stickmen.
