Parking: Close-in parking at Ford Park will cost \$10 from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM June 29 through July 7. Parking is free at the Vail and Lionshead parking structures and 10 minute bus service is offered from the Vail parking structure to Ford Park. Parking on the Frontage Road is only allowed when the parking structures are filled to capacity and then only until 11 pm. Detailed parking and bus information is available at www.vaileventparking.com.

Ford Fields: From I-70 take the Vail exit (Exit 176); To the South of I-70 is a traffic circle and S. Frontage Road. Take S. Frontage Road to the East along the highway. On your right you will see a parking garage, take note, you may need to park there. As you proceed Ford Field will be on your right, go past it and you will see the primary parking area on your right, the Vail Tennis Center. Note: The Tennis Center lot fills quickly and parking along Frontage Road is often prohibited so by parking there you may receive a ticket or be towed.

Donovan Park: From I-70 take the Vail exit (Exit 176); To the South of I-70 is a traffic circle and S. Frontage Road. Take S. Frontage Road to the West along the highway. Continue past Lionshead and Cascade Village. The field is on your left. If you hit West Vail, you've gone too far.

Athletic Field: From I-70 take the Vail exit (Exit 176); To the South of I-70 is a traffic circle and S. Frontage Road. Go East on S. Frontage Road. Turn Right on Vail Valley Drive and wind down across Gore Creek, up and past Golden Peak Ski School, then you'll see it on your right hand side.

Vail Mountain School: From I-70 take the East Vail exit (Exit 180). Turn left onto Big Horn Rd. Turn left onto I-70 Frontage Rd W. Turn right onto Booth Falls Rd. Destination will be on the right. VMS - 3000 Booth Falls Rd

I-70 construction this summer - We wanted to make you aware of a construction project on I-70 that will most likely impact your travel time when traveling on I-70 between Denver and Vail this summer. On a portion of I-70 in the mountains, eastbound traffic will be routed onto a frontage road that parallels I-70, then routed back onto I-70. Two lanes of traffic, both eastbound and westbound, will remain open during peak travel times. Traffic may be stopped for 20 to 30 minutes while blasting is taking place. When making your travel plans you may want to allow some extra time for delays on I-70 due to this project -- we would recommend allowing an extra 45 minutes to 1 hour.
